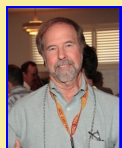

BAND REVIEW

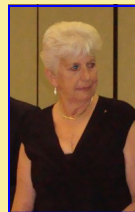
Lion Tom Gaebe who will once again be our Band Review Chairman this year announced that the Band Review will take place on Saturday October 12.
