Visalia Assistant School Superintendent Robert Groeber was our Guest Speaker Friday and he was here to update us on the Measure E and how the 60 million dollars from Measure E has helped in renovating our schools here in the Visalia Unified School District.

Robert explained that part of the Measure E funds will be used to place Solar Panels on 12 of the school campuses here in Visalia. Robert estimates that the VUSD will save an estimated 1 million dollars on energy costs a year.

Robert explained that most of the painting, plumbing, and electrical repairs and the general renovations of the schools that are needed are usually done during the summer vacation. Measure E funds are being used for these renovations.
